OCTOBER 20TH - PASSED CONGRESS, ORDERED ENROLLED.

A BILL TO

Direct the Association of Big Ten Students Liaison to compile and present a “Peer Wins Report” comparing student policy across the Big Ten.

Financial Impact: **None.**

Statute(s) Impacted: **None.**

Date Effective: **Upon Passage**

This bill represents the stance of the Indiana University student body as voiced through their elected representatives within the Indiana University Student Government (IUSG). It does not reflect the official position or endorsement of Indiana University as an institution, in accordance with IU policy GR-01 on contact with government officials.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.
SECTION 2.	PURPOSES & FINDINGS.
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BE IT ENACTED *by the students of Indiana University
in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This bill shall be cited as the “Peer Wins Report Act.”

3 **SECTION 2. Purposes & Findings.**

4 Congress finds that:

5 1. The Association of Big Ten Students serves as a
6 collaborative forum through which student
7 governments across the Big Ten share best
8 practices and coordinate advocacy on issues of
9 mutual concern.

10 2. Indiana University Student Government benefits
11 from benchmarking its policies, programs, and
12 advocacy efforts against those of peer institutions
13 to identify effective strategies and opportunities for
14 improvement.

15 3. A structured “Peer Wins Report” would
16 institutionalize the sharing of this comparative
17 insight within Congress and enhance data-driven
18 policymaking.

19 **SECTION 3. Directive.**

20 R.B. § 4-13-1(d) is amended to add the following:

21 “(5) shall prepare a Peer Wins Report every other month
22 starting in November 2025.

23 (A) The report shall include, at a minimum:

- 24 (i) Summaries of at least three significant initiatives,
25 reforms, or programs adopted by student governments at
26 other Big Ten universities during the current session;
- 27 (ii) Analysis of which initiatives may be replicable or
28 adaptable at Indiana University; and
- 29 (iii) Recommendations for further research or legislative
30 action.
- 31 (B) The Liaison shall submit the Peer Wins Report to the
32 Speaker of Congress, Recorder of Congress, and the
33 Chairs of all standing committees as a communication no
34 later than the 1st day of the month the report is set to be
35 due.
- 36 (C) The Recorder shall ensure the report is:
- 37 (i) Placed on the General Assembly agenda for
38 presentation and discussion; and
- 39 (ii) Published in the Congressional online repository
40 maintained by the Recorder under R.B. § 2-7-3.
